



Three Oaks Parkway Extension / Daniels Parkway Improvements Project July 2026 Update

Three Oaks Parkway new traffic pattern shift August 3, 2026 Palomino Lane traffic shift August 3, 2026

Phase 2 of this project consists of continuing the 4-lane segment of Three Oaks Parkway north from Phase 1 (approximately 800 feet south of the new Fiddlesticks Boulevard/Three Oaks Parkway intersection) to Daniels Parkway and realigning Fiddlesticks Boulevard via a new roundabout intersection. Daniels Parkway will be widened to four lanes in each direction; a new signal will be installed at Powers Court / Apaloosa Lane and the intersections of Daniels Parkway at Three Oaks Parkway will include dual left turn lanes for each leg of the intersection to provide more capacity for left turns.

Beginning the last week in July, crews will pave the new Three Oaks Parkway southbound lanes south from Daniels Parkway to the new intersection at Fiddlesticks Boulevard.

The following traffic pattern changes will begin on August 3, 2026, see map below:

- ***Southbound traffic will be shifted to the inside lane of the new southbound Three Oaks Parkway.***
- ***There will be right-in/right-out turning movements at Cody Lee Road and the new southern Publix Shopping Center entrance.***
- ***Northbound traffic on Three Oaks Parkway remains on the current outside lane. Left turns will be permitted into the new southern Publix Shopping Center entrance.***
- ***Old Fiddlesticks Boulevard will be closed between the roundabout and the southern access to the Publix Shopping Center at the Fiddlesticks Cafe to facilitate final construction of this roadway segment.***
- ***Phase 1 will remain closed.***
- ***In preparation for the improvements to Palomino Lane, northbound traffic will be shifted to the west into the bi-directional left turn lane north of Jobe Road/Kings Crossing.***

Please drive with caution and watch for workers in these areas. All work is subject to weather conditions.
